- Follow closely the implementation of the inDemand co-creational model in one of the pilot regions • (Murcia, Oulu or Paris region)
- Take the necessary steps to replicate the model in the region, including but not limited to: .
 - needs identification with the health care provider 0
 - selection of priority needs for which solutions will be co-created by an ICT company and the 0 health care provider
 - launching a competitive call to procure the digital solution needed 0
 - selection of the successful applicant (ICT company) 0
 - co-creation of the solution by the ICT company and the health care provider 0
 - validation of the solution 0
